Prism-Rainbow David E Adler Fine Rugs Dyeing The dyeing technique is important and a subject I defer to the experts on. Together with fiber type, it determines the quality of a rugs' color retention. The fiber can be enhanced by resilience, stain, soil, static, flame, and bacterial resistance treatments.


From a Berlin designer, this rug is lush and incredibly soft. No doubt, this would be the focal point of the room. Or, you could go all-natural. "Cave Drawings†is one of the non-dyed color selections at Organic Looms. When a rug is "nondyed,†it is as natural as an area rug can be. The process entails sheering the sheep, spinning the yarn, and then goes directly to weaving and finishing. No dyes of any

kind are used.
